

1 (Item) From the District Attorney, requesting authorization to create 1.0 FTE  
 2 Victim/Witness Advocate position to implement a Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN)

7 WHEREAS, on October 1, 2019, the Wisconsin Department of Justice  
 8 notified the Milwaukee County District Attorney’s Office of a grant award identified as  
 9 Project Safe Neighborhoods Eastern District 2018-PE-01-15399 in the amount of  
 10 \$316,576; and

 12 WHEREAS, the award included compensation for a Victim/Witness Advocate for  
 13 a period of approximately two years; and

 15 WHEREAS, the PSN grant funds 100 percent of project expenses without a local  
 16 match requirement; and

 18 WHEREAS, no appropriation of funds will be required for the creation of the new  
 19 PSN position, which will be filled in Pay Period 2 of 2020 at the earliest; and

 21 WHEREAS, budgetary authority for the 2020 portion of the project expenditures  
 22 and offsetting revenue for the PSN grant was included in the District Attorney’s 2020  
 23 budget; therefore,

 25 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby  
 26 authorizes and approves the creation of one (1.0) grant funded FTE Victim/Witness  
 27 Advocate in the District Attorney’s Office, effective at the start of 2020 Pay Period 2 on  
 28 December 30, 2019:
