- A. Approval of this resolution will provide authorization to reallocate and realign up to \$28,091,983 of federal American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF), and tax levy funds. The realignment is proposed to ensure that Milwaukee County meets all ARPA obligation and expenditure deadlines. ARPA funds must be obligated by December 31, 2024 and fully expended by December 31, 2026. To ensure compliance and reach 100% obligation by the federal deadline, this report recommends:
 - 1.) Funding approved ARPA projects with tax levy and reallocating tax levy expenditures to ARPA revenue in an equivalent amount (up to \$28,091,983); and
 - 2.) Reallocating \$1,740,000 of ARPA funds across existing ARPA-approved projects.
- B. Approval of this ARPA re-allocation provides up to \$28,091,983 in tax levy expenditures to federal ARPA State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF). Approval of this resolution reallocates \$1,740,000 of ARPA SLFRF funds across ARPA-approved projects. These actions will have a net total tax levy impact of \$0.
- C. Costs are anticipated to be effective in 2024 and may carry forward until as late as 2026 based on ARPA timeline requirements. Approval of the proposed projects does not have any budgetary impacts.
- D. No assumptions or interpretations were made.
