- A. Approval of this resolution will authorize the carryover of unspent Opioid Settlement Funds allocated to Cohort 1 projects through 12/31/26. The projects will address the opioid crisis across Milwaukee County through treatment, harm reduction, prevention, and other strategies as approved in the national settlement agreements.
- B. Approval of this resolution will provide additional time for programs to spend their allocated funds. It will not impact the tax levy or provide additional funds to new or currently funded projects.
- C. Approved County Board Resolution 21-1127 called for establishing a segregated Opioid Abatement Account not part of the general fund. Costs for these 15 projects are anticipated to be incurred effective December 31, 2026.
- D. No assumptions or interpretations were made when preparing this fiscal note.
