14 15	WHEREAS, WisDOT has awarded the Milwaukee County Sheriff a 2014 Alcohol

18 19 20	WHEREAS, the grant period is from October 1, 2013, until September 30, 2014, and it is anticipated that there will be 101 mandated deployments and other deployments for a total of 1,632 enforcement hours; and

22 23 24	WHEREAS, payment is based on an average overtime/fringe hourly rate of \$53.01 per hour and equipment expenditure authority of \$4,815 for seven (7) Personal Breathalyzer Test units and 5,000 Personal Breathalyzer Test tubes; and

26 27	25% or \$22,832, bringing the total project funding to \$114,159; and
