From the Executive Director of Parks, requesting authorization to enter into a Storm Sewer Easement with the Village of Greendale to install, maintain and operate Storm Sewer Infrastructure on land located in Scout Lake Park, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on the southeastern end of Scout Lake Park (the Park), in the area south of the playground, a cul-de-sac exists on the northern end of South 60th Street that was built entirely within the Park boundaries; and

WHEREAS, this cul-de-sac includes a storm water basin that is currently clogged, and the clogged stormwater infrastructure causes flooding during rain events and snow melt in the cul-de-sac and the Park; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Greendale (the Village) is proposing to install new storm water infrastructure to alleviate this issue, and in order to do so, they are requesting a Storm Sewer Easement (the Easement), which will allow them to correct this issue and prevent the flooding that occurs in the cul-de-sac and the Park; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) retains the right to require a Right-of-Entry Permit for all work on parkland; and

WHEREAS, it is the Village's role and responsibility to identify, propose, and pay for the infrastructure, as well as all required future maintenance and repairs; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Milwaukee County will work in good faith to resolve property boundary issues including, but not limited to, dedicating the cul-de-sac as right of way; and

WHEREAS, DPRC has reviewed this request and based on the size of the Easement, the minimal impact to parkland, natural areas, and recreational activities, and the overall benefit to the community as it relates to providing storm water drainage for the Park, is recommending approval of this Easement; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks and Culture, at its meeting of March 4, 2025, recommended adoption of File No. 25-176 (vote 7-0); now, therefore,

 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Director, Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC), the Department of Administrative Services (DAS), the Register of Deeds, Corporation Counsel, and Risk Management, DAS, to prepare, review, approve, execute, and record all documents, and take all actions as required, to grant the Village of Greendale the required Storm Sewer Easement (the Easement) with DPRC; and
