


- Expanded Seasonal Ranger recruiting efforts (includes retention)
- Received mental illness recognition training as well as Narcan training
- Increased our Fee Compliance revenue by 11%
- Continued Safety Collaboration meetings with MCSO
- Collaborated with other departments such as the Office of Emergency Management for training opportunities and better communication

## **Patrol Hours**



- Have over 15,500 acres of parks to patrol
- Overtime restricted for China Lights, Senior On Call Manager duties, and Aquatics patrols ONLY
- As in years past, Ranger staff frequently shifted assigned hours to accommodate special events and specific/detailed patrol directives (1,649.25 hrs. @ China Lights)
- 87,681 miles (safely driven) placed onto five assigned vehicles
- 836.5 hours patrolled at Aquatic centers/pools in a three-month period




## **Calls for Service**



- 559 Calls for Service \*Incidents or activities that Rangers observe or manage during patrols are not included
- Calls in summer months accounted for 58.7%
- 31.7% or 177 calls were for Parking complaints
- 94.6 % of calls occurred between 8a and 8p
- Calls for service are *only* from either dispatch or Ranger hotline (414-257-7777)






#### CALLS FOR SERVICE CENTRAL REGION






### CALLS FOR SERVICE NORTH REGION




- 2,199 total permits sold
- 2,166 hours patrolled
- \$24.69/hour while on Fee Compliance focused patrols
- Patrol to enforce rules and "petiquette" is being adhered to is main priority





## **Disc Golf**

- 1,988 total permits sold
- 1,518.5 hours patrolled
- \$23.43/hour while on Fee Compliance focused patrols
- Ensure all that are 17 and up have a permit to play






## **Parking Citations**




- Assumed all Parks Parking Citation payments at the beginning of 2024
  - Previously collected only \$29 for each paid citation
  - Now collecting \$35 for each paid citation plus late fees
  - Have autonomy to work with citizen on payment before sending to court
- 40% of issued citations were after parks closed







 \$302,645 in Ranger generated revenues encompassing Dog Exercise Areas, Disc Golf Courses, and Parking Citations

- Navigated July 27 & 28 multiple, well-attended Special Events: Harley Homecoming, Air Show, Brewfest (one day), and German Fest (not a Parks event-Summerfest Grounds) = 327 hours of Ranger patrols this weekend
- Successful coordination of the purchase of 17 AEDs (2023) and their strategic placement in the parks, coupled with Rangers CPR training, directly contributed to saving lives. - Extra administrative and clerical responsibilities, dedicating time to assist with the (continued issuance) and collection of citations in collaboration with the finance team. This initiative should result in more than \$100,000 in additional revenue

## 2025 Goals



- Sponsor Ranger staff to take Conversational Spanish courses at M.A.T.C.
- Increase Fee Compliance Revenue by 10%
- Apply for Grants to purchase much needed safety equipment for Rangers(e.g. ballistic vesting)
- Continue to expand both seasonal and full-time recruitment
- Expand, support, and foster training opportunities for all Parks staff
