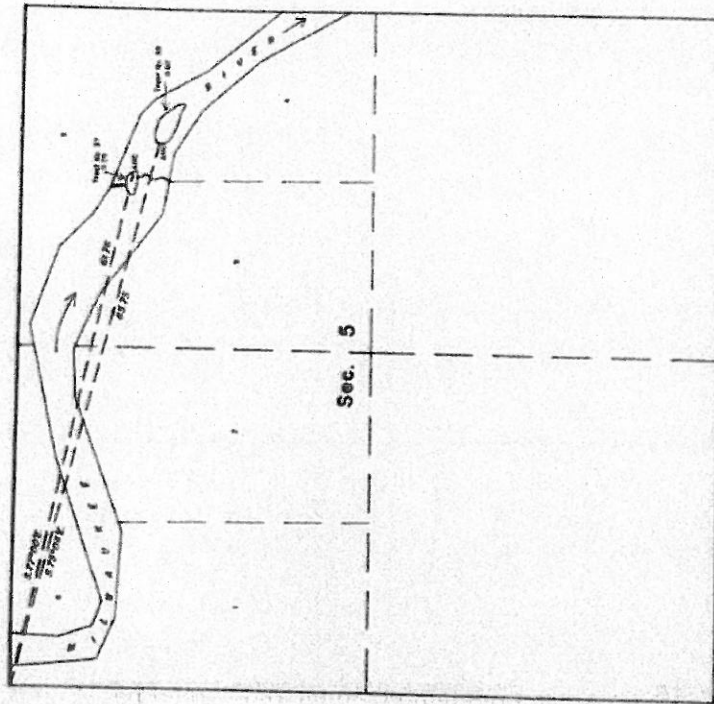


DUPLICATE
