From the Director, Department of Transportation, and the Airport Director, Requesting the Continued Extension of Judah Sambo-Mahekeya’s Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification (TAHC) to the Position of Airport Public Safety and Security Manager from May 1, 2020 Through October 31, 2020 or Until the Position is Filled, by recommending adoption of the following:

AN ENGROSSED RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Chapter 17.085 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances requires that an extension of Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification (TAHC) beyond 180 days be approved by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board); and

WHEREAS, the Airport Director, Milwaukee Mitchell International Airport, requests the continuation of Mr. Judah Sambo-Mahekeya’s TAHC to the position of Airport Public Safety and Security Manager from May 1, 2020, through October 31, 2020, or until the position is filled; and

WHEREAS, the request is being made to maintain consistent leadership during the recruitment process for the permanent filling of the Airport Public Safety and Security Manager position; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of March 11, 2020, recommended adoption of File No. 20-213 (vote 4-0); ~~now, therefore,;~~ **and**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the Committee on Personnel meeting, it was learned that the actual expiration date of the TAHC was February 10, 2020, and retroactive authorization by the County Board is required to ensure the incumbent is paid the proper amount; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the continued extension of Mr. Judah Sambo-Mahekeya’s Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification to the position of Airport Public Safety and Security Manager from ~~May 1, 2020~~ **February 11, 2020**, through October 31, 2020, or until the position is filled- **, whichever is sooner.**
