SUBJECT: **Request for authorization for the Chief Judge to execute a contract with the Alma Center for 12 months under the MacArthur Safety and Justice Challenge Grant.**

BACKGROUND

On April 13, 2016 Milwaukee County received from the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation a funding award notice for the Safety and Justice Challenge Phase II Implementation grant in the amount of \$2,000,000. The award period was from May 1, 2016 to April 30, 2018. A no cost extension was granted through December 31, 2019.


On October 3, 2018 Milwaukee County submitted a Phase III Implementation and Community Engagement grant. On December 20, 2018 Milwaukee County received a funding award notice for the Phase III grant. The Phase III application included funding in the amount of \$106,966 for case management and treatment services for the domestic violence deferred prosecution program developed under Phase II of the grant.

The Chief Judge recommends that the contract with the Alma Center be authorized.
