

ARPA Task Force Presentation: Project Adjustments



Background

- During the Finance Committee on July 25, 2024, the Office of the Comptroller indicated a potential deficit in the range of \$17 to \$19 million
- Projected deficit is a result of:
 - Decline in sales tax revenues
 - Overtime spending in the Office of the Sheriff & Community Reintegration Center
 - Other departmental projections



Addressing the Budget Deficit

- To address the budget deficit, Administration recommends ARPA budget adjustments for a total reduction of \$3.26 million
- These funds will support an increased budget for Public Health and Safety operational costs, or other ARPA SLFRF eligible costs.
- Administration identified an additional \$15.74 million in tax levy budget modifications for Board authorization.
