A Lease Agreement with the UW-Extension community garden program for the management of seven existing community garden locations in Forest Hill, Kohl, Rainbow, Cupertino, Firefly Ridge, Moody, and Sherman Parks. If adopted, Milwaukee County Parks would have no formal management obligations of these locations.
 - B. Milwaukee County would not be obligated for any costs associated with managing these community gardens. UW-Extension provides funds to employ staff, manage and maintain Milwaukee County land designated for the community garden program, pay for equipment maintenance and purchases, and offer educational programs to gardeners. UW-Extension is also required to return revenue to the County annually to pay water costs associated with the gardens.
 - C. None. These garden locations have been managed by UW-Extension in prior growing seasons, this proposed action would formalize this management under a Lease Agreement.
