- A. From the Executive Director of Milwaukee County Parks requesting authorization to enter into a subrecipient agreement with the City of Milwaukee to accept funding from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA)'s Urban and Community Forestry Grant.
- B. The City of Milwaukee would pass through USDA Urban and Community Forestry grant funding to Milwaukee County Parks to provide additional revenue for Forestry Team operations.
- C. \$1.5 million in funding from the USDA will pass through the City of Milwaukee to Milwaukee County Parks over a five year period. For the purpose of the fiscal note, Milwaukee County Parks expects \$300,000 in funding per year over a five-year period. These funds will be allocated to support activities identified in the grant, including tree planting and maintenance, tree pruning, stump removal and site restoration, poor conditioned tree removal, de-paving and tree planting. Funding will also allow for the renting of equipment and materials to support these activities.
- D. No assumptions were utilized in this analysis.
