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- A. Approval of this resolution would authorize the creation of 1.0 FTE of Enhanced Multi-Disciplinary Team (EMDT) Prevention Coordinator.
 - B. Funding is available through the State of Wisconsin Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) starting October 1, 2023 to January 1, 2024 and federal Department of Justice-Office of Violence Against Women Abuse in Later Life January 2, 2024 to December 31, 2025.
 - C. For 2023, the total annual cost for the position would be \$44,298 assuming a midpoint salary and social security as of pay period 12 (May 29, 2023). The ongoing annual salary and social security cost is \$76,782. In addition, active fringe benefit costs associated with this position would also be reimbursed.
 - D. It is assumed that this position would be absorbed into the DHHS budget and offset by a vacancy in the department or another funding source will be identified once the identified revenue ends on December 31, 2025.
