A RESOLUTION

authorizing and directing the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture to proceed with developing constructions plans for a compromise design referred to as "Alternative C" for Capital Project WP071401 (Kinnickinnic River Parkway-Jackson Park Drive) and present the design with estimated construction costs to the board prior to submitting the department's 2025 capital project requests

WHEREAS, Jackson Park Drive, a segment of the broader Kinnickinnic River Parkway, from 47<sup>th</sup> Street to 5800 W Cleveland Ave located within the City of Milwaukee is undergoing planning and design by the Milwaukee County Parks Department to reconstruct the road segment with reduced capacity pursuant to Parks Department goals to reduce hard surface roadways and expand trails in the County Park system; and

WHEREAS, the current surface of Jackson Park Drive was reconstructed in 1984, with a design life of 20 years, meaning the current deteriorated condition has outlived its expected life by more than 20 years; and

WHEREAS, a 2016 budget allocation (WP29004) and subsequent fund transfer (WP71401) in 2019 regarding reconstruction of seven sections of the Kinnickinnic Parkway was proposed and approved to achieve multiple goals including addressing poor road conditions, helping achieve Milwaukee County sustainability goals, reducing pavement in the parks system, protecting water resources and natural habitat, and reducing point sources of runoff and contamination; and

WHEREAS, four alternative designs for Jackson Park Drive were explored by the department in the preliminary planning phase, these included:

## • Alternative A - Road & Trail

- Reconstruct city road in-kind; reduce width of Jackson Park Drive to just north of northernmost driveway on westbound side; 10-ft trail alongside narrowed JPD; reconstruct remainder in-kind
- Alternative B Partial Trail Conversion
  - Reconstruct city road and county parks road from 47<sup>th</sup> to 51<sup>st</sup> in kind: Convert road to 10-ft trail in-between
- Alternative C Road and Trail & Trail Only from 51<sup>st</sup> to 53<sup>rd</sup>

41 Reconstruct city road in-kind; Reduce width of Jackson Park Drive 42 from 53<sup>rd</sup> Street to the western County Park boundary; Convert 43 road to 10-ft trail from 53<sup>rd</sup> to 51<sup>st</sup>; 10-ft trail alongside narrowed JDP from approximately 47<sup>th</sup> Street to 51<sup>st</sup> Street; reconstruct 44 45 remainder in-kind 46 Alternative D – Roadway and 35% Curb & Gutter Replacement 47 Reconstruct Jackson Park Drive In-Kind and Replace 35% of the 48 Curb & Gutter 49 ; and 50 51 WHEREAS, the four alternative designs were ranked and scored based on the 52 following Milwaukee County Parks preference criteria: 53 Sustainability 54 Recreational opportunity 55 Part of transportation grid 56 Minimize impact to natural resources 57 58 ;and 59 60 WHEREAS, a survey taken at the Public Information Meeting on October 5, 2023 61 demonstrated a strong preference by residents and attendees for alternatives that don't 62 remove the roadway west of 53rd St; and 63 64 WHEREAS, despite near overwhelming community support against removing the roadway, and thus access to the front of 18 homes west of 53rd Street, the Milwaukee 65 66 County Parks Department confirmed on February 9, 2024 that they are proceeding with 67 preparing construction documents for Alternative B; and 68 69 WHEREAS, Alternative B, Partial Trail Conversion, would effectively replace the 70 existing road on Jackson Park Drive with a 10' wide bike trail from the 5600 block to 51st 71 street; and 72 73 WHEREAS, Alternative B would have significant negative impact on 18 74 households who located on Jackson Park Drive and constructed facing Jackson Park 75 Drive west of 53rd Street and would lose road access to the front of their homes; and 76 77 WHEREAS, any 2025 departmental capital budget requests are due by summer 78 2024, then proceed to be heard by the County's Capital Improvements Committee (CIC) 79 in August which evaluates and ranks all requested projects and provides a 80 recommendation to the County Executive for the upcoming capital budget; and 81

WHEREAS, construction of any proposed project for Jackson Park Drive has not been requested, evaluated by the CIC, recommended by the County Executive, approved by the County Board, or granted any capital expenditure authority at this time; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks and Culture, at its meeting of March 12, 2024, recommended adoption of File No. 24-350 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes and directs the Department of Parks, Recreation and Culture to proceed with developing construction plans for a compromise design referred to as "Alternative C" for Capital Project WP071401 (Kinnickinnic River Parkway-Jackson Park Drive), and present the design with estimated construction costs as an informational report to the Board prior to submitting the department's 2025 capital project requests.
