REQUEST

From the Executive Director of Milwaukee County Parks requesting authorization to apply for and accept State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Inflation Reduction Act Grant

POLICY

State statute provides that the County Board may accept donations and grants for any public governmental purpose within the powers of the county.

BACKGROUND

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR) administers the Inflation Reduction Act Grant under Wisconsin State Statute 23.097 and Chapter NR 47.

The DNR's Inflation Reduction Act Grant program is designed to support projects and programs that improve a community's capacity to manage its tree canopy. Toward that end, the Parks Department seeks this funding to support the department's reforestation efforts to:

- Plant 260 2" diameter landscape trees across Milwaukee County at select parks;
- Convert eight acres of land to natural areas by planting 969 native trees and shrubs;
- Support the Milwaukee County Zoo by reforesting two acres of land at the Zoo by planting 950 trees;
- Promote equity and climate change resilience in disadvantaged communities with training, community outreach, and tree removal events.

The estimated cost of the project is \$369,292.69 which will be paid entirely by this grant.

Milwaukee County will not be required to provide a match.

In accordance with grant requirements, Milwaukee County Parks identifies the Operations Manager – Land Resource Division as the Authorized Representative to complete the following:

- Sign and submit the grant application;
- Sign a grant agreement between Milwaukee County Parks and the DNR;
- Submit interim and/or final reports to the DNR to satisfy the grant agreement;
- Submit grant reimbursement request to the DNR;
- Sign and submit other required documentation.

Work resulting from this award would occur during a three-year period between September 2024 and September 2027.
