From the Director of the Office of Strategy, Budget and Performance (OSBP), at the 1 request of the Milwaukee County Courts and the Milwaukee Community Justice 2 Council, requesting reallocation of \$2,313,170.45 in State ARPA funding dedicated to 3 the Courts system for backlog management pertaining to a revised MOU, and a 4 reallocation of tax levy in an equal amount. 5 6 A RESOLUTION 7 8 WHEREAS, Governor Evers, as announced on March 14, 2022, provided an 9 allocation of nearly \$16 million of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds from the 10 State of Wisconsin to Milwaukee County for expanded court operations; and 11 12 WHEREAS, within File 22-476, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors 13 authorized funding allocations related to the State of Wisconsin ARPA allocation for 14 15 court operations; and 16 WHEREAS, funds were earmarked for expanding court operations, pretrial 17 improvements, as well as employment and vocational preparedness programs at the 18 Milwaukee County Community Reintegration Center; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin and Milwaukee County executed a 21 22 Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) directing use of these funds to dedicated purposes on November 30, 2022; and 23 24 WHEREAS, it is currently estimated that \$2,313,170.45 of funding within the 25 26 MOU allocation has not been spent; and 27 WHEREAS, the State of Wisconsin and Milwaukee County jointly agreed to 28 revise and update the ARPA MOU to reallocate unspent ARPA funds and ensure timely 29 expenditure of allocated ARPA funds; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the revised MOU creates a \$2,313,170.45 budget line which 32 reallocates unspent funding to "Milwaukee County Sheriff Office personnel and other 33 related expenditures or Milwaukee County Courts operations," which allows Milwaukee 34 County to use ARPA funds to cover court backlog and operational needs, including 35 relevant expenditures that were initially supported with tax levy funds in the 2024 36 County budget; and 37 38 WHEREAS, criminal legal system partners have collectively identified high-39

priority public safety needs to be addressed by the aforementioned budget line,

including courtroom clerk and law enforcement staffing, interpreters, prosecutorial support staff, evidence room needs, as well as other critical resources and supplies to streamline case processing; and

WHEREAS, courts backlog management activities are expected to be continued in 2025, including the needs which have been identified in the proposed reallocation; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the OSBP, working in conjunction with the Office of the Comptroller (Comptroller), to process administrative appropriation transfer(s) to reallocate (up to) \$2,313,170.45 of unspent State ARPA funds (based off the revised MOU) for courts operations to support the cost of Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office personnel and other related expenditures or Milwaukee County Courts operations backlog:
