Approval of this resolution will have Milwaukee County government call upon the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) to hold public listening sessions distinct from their public information and “public involvement” meetings whereby WisDOT officials would only listen to neighborhood and County public sentiment. The resolution would further call upon WisDOT to eliminate as much of the Stadium Freeway, formally designated as Wisconsin State Trunk Highway (STH) 175, as possible to reconnect neighborhoods and return land to the property tax rolls. Lastly, this resolution would authorize and request the Office of Government Affairs to communicate this resolution with various State policymakers.
 - B. This resolution does not obligate any funds. Staff time will be required to communicate the contents of this resolution to the Wisconsin Governor, State lawmakers, and WisDOT.
 - C. This resolution has no budgetary impact.
 - D. No assumptions were used.
