The EMS Division has taken on the creation and maintenance of the electronic patient care record software system for the entire EMS system consisting of 14 municipal fire and EMS agencies with more than 112,000 patient documents created annually. This project requires an additional person for support and maintenance of a critical function of the EMS System.
- B. By abolishing the EMS Lieutenant position that entire salary amount would be shifted towards this new position with a very minimal increase of just over \$500 to support the new position.
