- The ADRC is preparing for the annual **ADRC Celebration** on May 7 as May is ADRC Recognition Month. This year's event will be held at Washington Park Senior Center and will be a celebration honoring the community, the ADRC staff and highlighting the services available to help older adults and adults with disabilities.
- The ADRC's Community Health Worker program recently hired a new member of their team and is now fully staffed. They are working at a wide range of community sites to strengthen relationships with community partners and expand site coverage. These include: Milwaukee County Veteran Services, Jefferson Court, Mercy House, Outreach Community Health Center, United Community Center, and Independence First. The team also engaged several additional partners to explore new site coverage opportunities, including 16th Street Community Health Center, Greendale Health Department, Progressive Health Center, South Milwaukee Health Department, St. Francis Health Department, Wauwatosa Library, Franklin Library, LGBT Community Center, Wauwatosa Health Department, Vivent Health, UMOS, Wellpoint, ArchWell Health Center, and Forest Home Health Center.
- On March 12, we held the Quarterly Partners meeting. This meeting brings together the partners from the long term care network: the ADRC, Income Maintenance, Family Care, PACE Partnership, and IRIS providers. The meeting was held at Milwaukee Enrollment Services (MILES) and the new providers to GSR7 were introduced.
