### Referrals Received from the County Board Chairperson For the County Board Meeting on May 24, 2012

ORD From the Director, Department of Transportation (DOT), requesting authorization to amend Ordinance 15.17(2) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances to reduce the DOT Highway Division Imprest Fund from \$1,150 to \$150.

ORD A resolution/ordinance by Supervisors Cullen, Johnson, Jr., Borkowski, Broderick, Jursik, Dimitrijevic, West, Haas, Lipscomb, Sr., Schmitt, Taylor, Sanfelippo, Harris, Alexander, Stamper II, and Bowen, to merge the Committees on Finance and Audit and Personnel into a nine-member standing committee with two co-chairpersons to improve the efficiency of legislative oversight and to amend Chapters 1, 17, 32, 33, 46, 56, 57, 73, 79, 80, 201, and 203 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances to reflect this change.
