A new professional service agreement with HGA Architects to provide professional services for the 2016 Capital Project WP490 Mitchell Park Horticultural conservatory Future Path & Feasibility Study is being requested that would require \$156,130.00. The funding would be taken from the specially created sub-account designated for "Long Term Planning" that was set up for use by the Domes Task Force.
