

Milwaukee County Commission on Aging Aging Services Director's Report – October 2024

Administration

- Facilitated public hearings on goals for the 2025-27 Area Aging Plan.
- Attended 2024 AARP Livable Communities Workshop Designing for People.
- Planned follow-up from the Milwaukee County Aging Network Summit.
- Continued work on transition to Peer Place, the new WI-DHS OAA/ADRC data management application, including high level staff training.
- Completed FFY 2024 service & participant data entry for Older Americans Act services into SAMS including addition of Serving Older Adults data.
- Facilitated RFP process for Specialized Transportation & Catering.
- Completed Administrative Renewal contracts for existing Aging vendors.
- Received preliminary 2025 Older Americans Act allocation from WI-DHS.
- Secured additional funding for the **DHHS website accessibility project**.

Advocacy

- Provided comments on the Wisconsin DOT's ADA Transition Plan.
- Provided comment on the Growing MKE initiative.
- Provided comments on the Governor's Task Force on the Healthcare Work Force recommendations.
- Provided comments on the U.S. Access Board's Proposed Rule on ADA Compliance of Electric Vehicle Charging Stations.
- Joined the Policy Champions Committee of the Wisconsin Coalition for Social Connection, supporting state and national policy initiatives that increase social connections for older adults and people with disabilities.
- Selected to serve on the American Society for Aging's Health and Well-Being Advisory Council for the 2024-2026 term.
- Submitted Wisconsin State Budget Aging Priorities to DHHS Leadership.
- Hosted three Medicare 101 Presentations at the Shorewood Senior Center, Greendale Public Library, and Indian Council for the Elderly.
- Met with Legal Action of Wisconsin to address support of additional Elder Benefit Specialists in the ADRC.
- Participated in **Voter registration** promotion with Disability Vote Coalition.



Social Support Services

- Continued collaboration and coordination discussions with American Heart
 Association to advance Blood Pressure Heart Health Initiative in all five
 Milwaukee County owned Senior Centers.
- Initial discussion and collaboration with **MKE FreshAir Collective** to improve Air Quality and provide Interventions at Senior Centers.
- Continued collaboration and coordination with LGBT Community Center staff and SageCare in the completion of certification of SageCare training for LGBT Community Center staff.
- Launched Americorps Senior Companions program and onboarded Project Coordinator Deidra Williams. Attended Americorps trainings.
- Secured additional funding for Falls Prevention Home Repair program.

Transportation

- Finalized criteria and posted RFP for Older Adult Transportation Service.
- Submitted new federal Section 5310 Mobility Management grant proposal to fund Transportation Coordinator, provide for volunteer driver mileage, and acquire additional accessible vehicles in 2025-26.
- Received delivery of 3/8 new accessible vans for the OATS program.
- Collaborated with Wisconsin Bike Federation to host Cycling Without Age.

Senior Centers

- Received \$3.95 million grant to build a demonstration kitchen, makers space, health and wellness space, renovate dining area, and bring fiber optic internet into Clinton & Bernice Rose senior center.
- Pursuing strategies to ensure senior center programming in 2025.
- Met with Serving Older Adults to address budget and expectations for continued programming in the Milwaukee County senior centers.
- Supported Serving Older Adults **Art of Aging** resource fairs at Washington and Wilson park senior centers.
- Supported DHHS, County Executive, Parks, and Administrative Services initiative regarding Senior Center re-envisioning initiative.
- DAS Facilities plans implementation of fire safety, intrusion alarm and battery backup systems at all five Milwaukee County Senior Centers.
- Independence First completed accessibility review of all 5 senior centers.



Nutrition Services

- Completed construction of the new Washington Park senior center demonstration kitchen.
- Met with initial design team regarding the kitchen and dining room remodel at the Clinton Rose senior center.
- Selected Canteen (Compass Group) for the southside catering contract, which has a new food preparation and distribution facility in Oak Creek.
- Settled Goodwill contract costs for the Home Delivered Meal Program.
- Notified MCO's & ICA's of new senior meal program rates for Medicaid Long Term Care enrollees.

Health & Wellness

- ADS Vaccination Collaborative hosted over 23 vaccine clinics between September 21 and October 16. 124 Covid-19 and 78 flu immunizations were administered at these community events and via in-home vaccination.
- An additional 745 flu and 719 Covid immunizations were administered between September 21 and October 16 at partnering pharmacy locations.
- Added Vital Voices as an additional subgrantee for the Social Isolation and Loneliness (Rx Social Connect) grant to follow up with project participants who score high on the Loneliness Scale administered by pharmacists.
- Negotiated grant subaward agreements with Impower, Health Connections, Inc., HAFA, Outreach Community Health, and Hayat pharmacies to extend the Aging and Disability Vaccination Collaborative until July of 2025.
- Hosted 10 Health & Wellness workshops including Healthy Living with Diabetes.
- Met with Milwaukee County Behavioral Health to increase collaboration for older adult Mental Health services.

Caregiver Support

- Hired a second Caregiver Support Specialist. Alexa Law brings significant experience, having worked with the Family Caregiver Support Program at Interfaith Older Adult Programs and Alzheimer's Association.
- To date, have provided financial assistance to 202 families through AFCSP and NFCSP and have had 300 one-on-one contact with others individuals who have not participated in NFCSP and AFCSP.
- Collaborating with ADS staff members and community partners to plan events for National Family Caregiver Support Month in November 2024.
- Collaborated with the Wisconsin Family and Caregiver State Alliance to develop a National Family Caregiver Month Social Media Toolkit.
