ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The cost of the new position is offset by 66% federal cost reimbursement revenue as well as additional State General Purpose Revenue (GPR) revenue contained in the 2025 contract with the State Department of Children and Families (DCF) resulting in a net levy impact of \$0. Assuming the position is filled by pay period 10 the total fiscal impact results in an increase in operating expenditures by \$44,443 with a matching operating revenue increase of \$44,443.

CSS has contacted the State to determine if any possible change is anticipated in the 66% federal cost reimbursement. The State has advised that there are no changes in the federal budget bill. If this status should change, the State will notify CSS and convene a meeting with the child support administrator and directors.
