12 13 14	WHEREAS, Chapter 36 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances created the Capital Improvements Committee (CIC); and
15 16 17 18	WHEREAS, the purpose of the CIC is to develop, maintain, and update a long-term capital improvements program for Milwaukee County's construction and maintenance of infrastructure and facilities; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, the 2015 Adopted Capital Improvements Budget included an appropriation of \$9,154,472 for Project WP481 Parks Infrastructure Projects; and
23 24	WHEREAS, financing for the project is to be provided by general obligation bonds; and
25 26 27 28	WHEREAS, the Parks Director was directed to review the current CIC project list and make additional capital improvement recommendations to the CIC that could be implemented with the funds provided in Project WP481; and
29 30 31	WHEREAS, the Parks Director was directed to work with the Office of the Comptroller to determine which projects are eligible for bond financing; and
32 33 34 35	WHEREAS, the Parks Director was to focus on projects that positively impact the public's perception of park facilities, such as public restrooms and other high visibility projects; and
36 37 38 39	WHEREAS, priority shall be placed on residential hiring for contractors assigned to projects funded through this program in a manner consistent with Adopted Milwaukee County Board Resolution File No. 14-738; and
10 11 12	WHEREAS, the Parks Director has submitted recommendations to the CIC; and
13 14	WHEREAS, of the 16 projects identified by the Parks Director, 14 projects are on the August 2014 CIC list: and

WHEREAS, one of the two projects not included in the list was the Lake Park Ravine Bridge Replacement; and WHEREAS, on December 8, 2014, File No. 14-953, a Notification of Emergency Repair relating to the Lake Park Ravine Bridge, was submitted by the Director of Administrative Services to the County Executive and County Board Chairwoman pursuant to Section 44.14(6) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances; and WHEREAS, a vast majority of the expenses are eligible for bond financing; and WHEREAS, a limited number of the items with a total estimated expense of \$63,500 related to the Brown Deer Golf Course Kitchen Remodel Project will have to be cash financed; and WHEREAS, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) has indicated that those items will be financed from the DPRC operating budget; and WHEREAS, the CIC is to submit formal recommendations to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors; and WHEREAS, the CIC finalized its list of recommendations (Attachment A) at its March 17, 2015, meeting; and WHEREAS, the CIC recommends that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors and the County Executive approve the scope of work and financing for the projects listed in Attachment A; now, therefore, BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors authorizes the scope of work and financing for the projects listed in Attachment A; and BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Office of the Comptroller shall work with the Department of Administrative Services to process an administrative appropriation transfer to create the capital projects and reallocate funding from WP481 Parks Infrastructure Projects to the projects listed in Attachment A. \\Fi01wpchc\cntybrd\\$\Data\\Data\\Data\COMCLERK\Committees\2015\Mar\PE&E\Special PE&E\Resolution\15-
