14 15 16	WHEREAS, the Village is the current owner of a parcel of land known as Grootemaat Woods, which is also located in the County, the State; and		
17 18 19 20 21 22	WHEREAS, DPRC has partnered with the Village since 1995 for the management of the Parkway, which is located in the Village's downtown area, and the 1995 Lease Agreement that governs this partnership has expired, and the County and the Village have had discussions about the Village acquiring the Parkway in order to make improvements to it; and		
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS, under this arrangement, the Village has managed routine park maintenance, while the County retained responsibility for the creek bed itself (approximately 40 feet from the center line); and		
27 28 29 30 31	WHEREAS, one concept that has been proposed, and ultimately both parties agreed on, is a swap of land that is currently owned by the Village, Grootemaat Woods, 4300 West Ramsey Ave, the Village, which is 13.75 acres of land, in exchange for the Parkway, which is approximately 21.91 acres of land spread across 4 parcels; and		
32 33	WHEREAS, both properties will remain public parkland following this transaction, with Restrictive Covenants to be enacted against future development; and		
34 35 36 37	WHEREAS, the Village and County will record Quit Claim Deeds and Restrictive Covenants to document this transfer; and		
38 39 40	WHEREAS, the Committee on Parks and Culture, at its meeting of June 10, 2025, recommended adoption of File No. 25-371 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,		
41 42 43 44	BE IT RESOLVED, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture (DPRC) is hereby authorized to enter into this land swap with the Village of Greendale (the Village); and		
44 45 46 47	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, DPRC is authorized to prepare, execute, amend, record all documents, and take all actions necessary as required to execute and implement the land swap with the Village.
