From the Acting Director, Department of Health and Human Services, requesting authorization to create Section 4.02(2)(a) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances to install "homeless donation containers" at General Mitchell International Airport, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION/ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, on any given night in Milwaukee County (the County), there are 900 homeless people in need of shelter; and

WHEREAS, designated containers to collect spare change is an additional way to assist in the provision of the basic needs of the County’s homeless population; and

WHEREAS, the County's Housing Division has partnered with the Greater Milwaukee Foundation to create the Housing First Endowment to assist in funding the County’s plan to end chronic homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the high traffic at General Mitchell International Airport, and already having designated “Homeless Donation Containers,” will enable passengers to donate and deposit spare change prior to passing through the security checkpoints; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Economic and Community Development, at its meeting of May 14, 2018, recommended adoption of File No. 18-337 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby creates Section 4.02(2)(a) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances to install “Homeless Donation Containers,” by adopting the following:

AN ORDINANCE

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4.02(2)(a) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is created as follows:

4.02. - General regulations.

(1) *Commercial activity.* No person shall use the county's airports or any portions thereof for the conduct of a commercial enterprise, or other form of revenue producing activity, without first obtaining authorization therefor from the proper authorities of the county by means of a written agreement, lease, license, or permit and paying the rentals, fees and charges as established therefor.

(2) *Advertising and solicitation.* No person or organization of any nature shall post, distribute or display, including without restriction because of enumeration, signs, advertisements, literature, circulars, pictures, sketches, drawings or other forms of printed or written matter or engage in any form of solicitation upon the premises of the county's airports without prior written permission secured from or through the airport director, as may be required.

(a) The Airport Director may install one collection container at each of the security checkpoints at each of the passenger concourses at the airport for the purpose of collecting spare change donated and deposited by passengers prior to passing through the security checkpoints operated by the Transportation Security Administration (the "Homeless Donation Containers"). The Homeless Donation Containers placed in service as described in this subsection shall be constructed and paid for by Milwaukee County's program to assist the homeless administered by the Housing Division; no airport funds, nor any airport personnel shall be used for or involved in the construction, installation, maintenance, collection of funds from such containers, or for any other purpose related to this subsection. Prior to installation, operation, maintenance or removal, the Airport Director shall have the authority to approve the size, design, placement, and operation of all Homeless Donation Containers authorized by this subsection. Any funds deposited in the Homeless Donation Containers shall be collected by the Milwaukee County Housing Division (or its agent) at the location of each container in a manner and at a time approved by the Airport

Director. Any funds collected according to the terms of this subsection shall be used solely and exclusively for the Homeless Endowment.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication.
