

A request from the Sheriff, Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office to grant a leave of absence to an employee currently in the classified position of Deputy Sheriff Captain to assume the unclassified service position of Deputy Sheriff Director (working title Inspector) in accordance with Milwaukee County General Ordinances Chapter 17-193 (1) and (2), by recommending adoption of the following:

### A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Section 17.193(1) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances (the Code) and Section 59.26(1)(2), Wisconsin State Statutes (State Statutes), make provisions for counties under civil service to allow the Milwaukee County Sheriff (Sheriff), in conformity with the Code, to grant leaves of absence to deputy for appointment to higher positions; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2005, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors (County Board) created Section 17.193 of the Code, to provide a mechanism for the Sheriff to grant leaves of absence; and

WHEREAS, under Section 17.193 of the Code, the Sheriff may not grant a leave of absence until the Sheriff first secures the consent of the County Board by resolution duly adopted by the County Board; and

WHEREAS, granting leaves of absence will enhance the Sheriff's ability to administer her office efficiently and appoint subordinates in a manner most effective in fulfilling the statutory and constitutional duties of her office; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff requests a leave of absence for the following employee:

Current classified position:	Deputy Sheriff Captain (Civil Services — Classified)  (recently received Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification [TAHC] to Deputy Sheriff Director — working title Inspector)
Employee:	Tricia Carlson
New regular appointment unclassified position:	Deputy Sheriff Director (working title Inspector)
Effective date to extended current leave of absence:	Immediately upon adoption of resolution and appointment to unclassified position

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of May 6, 2025, recommended adoption of File No. 25-344 (vote 4-0); now, therefore,
