AN ORDINANCE

The Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors of the County of Mitwaukee does ordain as

Section 1, Section 32.67 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is hereby created as follows:

32.67. - Annual Hability cost reporting.

The risk management division, department of administrative services, in collaboration with corporation counsel, shall produce a report with corresponding data to the county board by October 1 annually, which includes total county liability costs for the prior year and to date for the current year, detailing the following:

- Total claim payments by department; and
 Total liability program costs for prior year and as much as is known of the current year, if applicable, including a description of any increases or decreases.

The definition of total claim payment, in this section only, shall be: all payments made on behalf of the county to defend against, or compensate third parties' damages for claims submitted against the county, which includes but is not limited to, payments for attorney's fees and costs, settlements, judgments, and jury awards.

The definition of liability program costs, in this section only, shall be: any fees charged for premiums, retentions, claims administration, loss control, actuarial reports, and any other costs necessary to administer the county's liability

Section 2. The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage and publication.
