MCDOT Requests Authorization for Fund Transfer

- The 30th Street Corridor Project would study the feasibility of a shared bicycle/pedestrian trail alongside a railroad corridor in Milwaukee's Northside
- The original grant was awarded in December 2023 to Milwaukee County Parks as part of their Oak Leaf Trail Network Plan for \$800,000 of Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2021 (CRRSAA) and \$128,000 of the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding
- This proposed fund transfer will create a MCDOT project reallocating \$800,000 to fund the 30th Street Corridor Project



30th Street Corridor Project

- With the fund transfer, MCDOT will facilitate the study and coordinate with local partners
- This 6.7-mile corridor would provide residents with opportunities for recreation, access to employment and education, and utilize infrastructure
- The feasibility study is estimated to be completed in Spring of 2027
- The trail would begin in the American Family Field area and end at Havenwoods State Forest
