  - B. The cost for the position create is approximately \$56,403 including social security thru June of 2024. The cost for the creation of the position will be absorbed within existing salary funding in the Department of Administration. There are no subsequent year cost due to the 2024 anticipated retirement.
  - C. Based on historical vacancy rates within DAS Facilities Maintenance Division, the costs to create this position will be absorbed within the 2024 salary budget.
  - D. It is assumed the incumbent will retire in June of 2024.
