(ITEM) From the Director, Office of Performance, Strategy, and Budget, Department of Administrative Services, requesting retroactive authorization to apply for and accept Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant funds for Federal Fiscal Year 2016, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2016, the Office of Performance, Strategy, and Budget, Department of Administrative Services, received notification from the United States Department of Justice (U.S. DOJ) that applications were released for the 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. DOJ requires the qualifying localities to negotiate a Memorandum of Understanding regarding the administration and distribution of funds; and

WHEREAS, the following localities: the City of Milwaukee (the City), Milwaukee County (the County), and the City of West Allis are eligible for funding in the total amount of \$937,932; and

WHEREAS, funding is awarded to municipalities based on the average annual number of Part One violent crimes reported by the unit to the Federal Bureau of Investigation; and

WHEREAS, since the County bears the cost of prosecution and incarceration that arise out of Part One violent crimes, the U.S. DOJ has declared the County a disparate jurisdiction and therefore eligible to share in the funding awarded to municipalities located within the County; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded \$915,769, which is 97.6 percent of all the local funds, with no attempt to extract funding from the municipalities other than the City of Milwaukee after discussions with Milwaukee Police Department (MPD); and

WHEREAS, it was agreed that funding would be split with MPD and the County each funding one-half of the cost of the Community Justice Council Coordinator position, housed at the Public Policy Forum at an amount totaling \$95,713; and

WHEREAS, of the remaining funding level of \$820,056, the County will receive \$410,028 or 50 percent of the City's award; and

WHEREAS, the grant does not require a local match; and

WHEREAS, the grant application submission deadline was June 30, 2016; and

47 WHEREAS, the County will be the fiscal agent for the grant; and

49 WHEREAS, in order to meet the grant requirements, a separate trust fund must
50 be established to deposit the grant monies which the County will receive; and

52 WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Safety, and General Services, at its
53 meeting of July 14, 2016, considered this resolution for informational purposes only; and

55 WHEREAS, the Committee on Finance and Audit, at its meeting of July 21, 2016,
56 recommended adoption of the Director's request (vote 6-0); now, therefore,

58 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby
59 retroactively authorizes the Office of Performance, Strategy, and Budget, Department of
60 Administrative Services, to apply for and accept Edward Byrne Memorial Justice
61 Assistant Grant funds; and

63 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, a separate trust fund is to be established for the
64 deposit of grant monies.
