## **REQUEST**

Milwaukee County Parks requests permission to utilize funds previously allocated for the sPark and Parks Amenity Matching Fund toward expenditure deficits in Parks 2024 operational budget.

#### **BACKGROUND**

Milwaukee County Parks seeks to re-allocate funds from the sPark/Parks Amenity Matching Fund, a Parks expandable trust, in the amount of \$156,094.90 and then close the fund. This fund provides matching County funds to any project approved by Parks that involves a third party willing to raise funds for the repair or enhancement of existing Parks facilities or amenities to preserve basis sanitary and safety conditions in all County parks. Parks awarded these funds in accordance with the program and board guidelines however some awardees returned the funds due to a lack of fundraising or change in plans.

The funds in this expendable trust have typically carried over year over year for utilization by Parks. In late 2023, Parks was advised by Comptroller Manske that the carryover of these funds does not adhere to standard accounting principles and the balance of the fund would need to be lapsed at the end of the year.

Given the change in practice, Parks was able to get agreement from the Comptroller's Office to allow for the carryover from 2023 into 2024 with the understanding that if the funds were not utilized in 2024, they would be lapsed.

At this time, Parks seeks to re-allocate the funds in the Parks Amenity Matching Fund to cover the 2024 operating budget deficit.
