- B. There are no direct costs, savings, or anticipated revenues associated with the proposed action in current or subsequent years.
- C. There are no budgetary impacts associated with the proposed action in current or subsequent years. Staff time, which was previously allocated through the 2021 Adopted Budget, will be necessary to update the MCGO and communicate the change.

Parks Department staff indicate severe staffing shortages already impact their ability to enforce Chapter 47.08 of the MCGO as it presently stands. The proposed Ordinance will require staff to enforce a more complex and nuanced system and will also require park users to successfully navigate a narrow set of rules. This policy may also lead to conflicts between parks users and park staff and rangers on the new foraging rules and guidelines. It should be noted this fiscal note does not attempt to estimate the cost of additional signage that may be needed to mark non-collection sites due to contaminated soil concerns. If signage is needed,
