7 \$15,000 by the Wisconsin Mutual Insurance Corporation on behalf of Milwaukee County  
8 to settle the matter of *Johnny Young, et al. v. Pamela Miller, et al., Milwaukee County*  
9 *Case No. 15-CV-2111*, by recommending adoption of the following:

11 **A RESOLUTION**

13 WHEREAS, on November 18, 2011, Johnny L. Young was injured due to a motor  
14 vehicle accident involving a Milwaukee County Sheriff's Office squad car owned by  
15 Milwaukee County (the County) and operated by a County employee; and

16  
17 WHEREAS, as a result of said incident, Mr. Young filed a lawsuit in Circuit Court,  
18 Case No. 15-CV-2111, against the County, seeking damages for injuries sustained in  
19 the November 18, 2011, incident; and

20  
21 WHEREAS, Mr. Young claims that he suffered neck and back injuries, and that  
22 he has incurred medical expenses attributable to the incident in the amount of  
23 \$16,810.20; and

25 WHEREAS, the parties engaged in court-ordered mediation and subsequent  
26 settlement discussions; and

28 WHEREAS, the tentative settlement agreement provides for a release of all  
29 claims in return for a payment by the Wisconsin County Mutual Insurance Corporation in  
30 the amount of \$15,000 to Mr. Young and his attorneys, Carlson, Blau, & Clemens, S.C.;

33 WHEREAS, the Office of Corporation Counsel recommends this settlement; and

35 WHEREAS, the Committee on Judiciary, Safety, and General Services, at its  
36 meeting of September 8, 2016, recommended adoption of Corporation Counsel's  
37 request (vote 4-0); now, therefore,

39 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors approves the  
40 payment by the Wisconsin County Mutual Insurance Corporation of \$15,000 on behalf  
41 of Milwaukee County to Mr. Johnny L. Young and his attorneys, Carlson, Blau, and  
42 Clemens, S.C., in exchange for dismissal of his suit and complete release of all claims  
43 against all defendants.
