9 AN ORDINANCE

11 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as follows:
12

13 **SECTION 1.** Section 4.05.09 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances is
14 created as follows:

16 **4.05.09. Transportation Network Companies**
17

18 (1) Definitions.
19

- 20 (a) Airport Director. The duly appointed incumbent of the position of
21 Airport Director at General Mitchell International Airport (GMIA), or the
22 person designated by him to act on his behalf.
23
- 24 (b) Commencement of Transportation Network Company Vehicle Service.
25 The first trip (as defined by this Section) of a Transportation Network
26 Company (TNC) vehicle.
27
- 28 (c) County Entity. Any entity controlled by Milwaukee County (the County).
29
- 30 (d) Geo-Fence. A virtual perimeter of a specific geographical location on
31 Airport property.
32
- 33 (e) Monthly Trip Fee. The total trip fees paid to the County in a given
34 calendar month.
35
- 36 (f) TNC Passenger Pick-Up Area. Any one of the three geographical areas
37 Designated in Exhibit A to this Permit as the permitted area in which
38 Permittee may pause to pick up TNC passengers.
39
- 40 (g) TNC Permit Fee. The \$125 fee for each TNC vehicle providing TNC
41 Services at GMIA during the term of this Permit.
42
- 43 (h) TNC Staging Area. The area designated on Exhibit A where TNC vehicles
44 may park and wait prior to proceeding to the TNC passenger pickup area.
45
- 46 (i) Transportation Network Company (TNC). A corporation, partnership, sole

47 proprietorship, or other entity, licensed under Section 440.4 et seq.,
48 Wisconsin State Statutes (State Statutes), to operate in Wisconsin, which
49 uses a digital network to connect riders to drivers for the purpose of
50 providing transportation. A TNC does not provide taxi service
51 transportation. A TNC does not provide taxi service, transportation
52 service arranged through a transportation broker, or any transportation
53 service over fixed routes at regular intervals. As used in this Permit, all
54 references to TNC are references to Permittee in particular.

- 56 (j) Transportation Network Company Driver (TNC Driver). An individual who
57 uses his or her vehicle to provide services for riders matched through a
58 TNC's digital network.
- 59
- 60 (k) Transportation Network Company Vehicle (TNC Vehicle). A vehicle driven
61 by a TNC Driver to provide transportation to riders using the TNC's digital
62 network.
- 63
- 64 (l) Trip. The loading of a passenger at GMIA in any one of the three TNC
65 Passenger Pick-Up Areas identified on Exhibit A attached to this Permit.
- 66
- 67 (m) Trip Fee. The fee paid by Permittee to the County for the privilege of
68 picking up a passenger at GMIA under the terms of this Permit.

70 (2) Licenses, Permits, Fees.

- 72 (a) All TNC's operating under this section shall satisfy all of the licensing
73 requirements required by Chapter 440, State Statutes, and sign an
74 airport permit similar in form to the TNC permit contained in Appendix G –
75 General Mitchell International Airport Transportation Network Company
76 Permit for Operation.

78 **SECTION 2.** The provisions of this Ordinance shall become effective upon passage
79 and publication.
