**2024 Intergovernmental Agreement between the Milwaukee County District Attorney's
Office and the South Milwaukee Police Department**

2024 Reimbursement Procedure for MMDEG Task Force Participation

In November of 2024, the Supervisory Commission of the Milwaukee Metropolitan Drug Enforcement Group (MMDEG) voted to transfer administrative and fiscal responsibility for the MMDEG grant from the Sheriff's Office to the District Attorney's office, effective January 1, 2005. The Sheriff's Office had served as the fiscal and administrative director of the MMDEG grant from 1999-2004, succeeding the District Attorney's office, which served in that role from 1989-98.

This intergovernmental agreement, under Wis. Stat. § 66.0301 and the 2024 county budget, authorizes the District Attorney's office to reimburse municipal police departments for the salaries and fringe benefits of police officers assigned full-time to MMDEG. This reimbursement to municipal police departments is offset entirely by federal and state revenue from the 2021 and 2022 JAG Drug Task Force Grants (Grant ID numbers 17874 and 18546, for calendar years 2023 and 2024, respectively) from the Wisconsin Department of Justice (WIDJ); it has no tax levy effect.

In 2024, the South Milwaukee Police Department will assign one police officer to work full-time in the MMDEG police unit. The District Attorney's office will reimburse the South Milwaukee Police Department for approximately 34 percent of the straight-time salary and fringe benefits of its officer, up to a maximum reimbursement of \$42,228, provided MMDEG grant funds are available in that amount, as authorized in the 2024 county budget, and as contained in the 2024 MMDEG grant budget, which was approved by the MMDEG Supervisory Commission on November 7, 2022.

The obligations under this agreement are contingent upon the award of a grant by the WIDJ in the amount of \$543,365 in connection with an application identified as "2022 JAG Drug Task Force Grant ID 18546." That award, which is for calendar year 2024, is comprised of funds from two sources: federal funds from the US Department of Justice, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (Byrne JAG) Program, and state penalty assessment dollars. The federal portion, \$321,147, comprises approximately 60 percent of the grant award; the state penalty assessment portion, \$222,218, makes up approximately 40 percent. WIDJ will not receive the FY 2024 Byrne JAG award from the U.S. Department of Justice (USDJ) until about May of 2024. WIDJ will make the state penalty assessment portion of the grant award available on January 1, 2024. The parties anticipate that the penalty assessment portion of the award will fund the MMDEG project until mid-to-late May 2024. However, funding under this contract, and District Attorney reimbursement for the costs of the South Milwaukee officer assigned to MMDEG, will end in the event that WIDJ does not receive the federal Byrne JAG award by the point that the state penalty assessment funds run out.

The South Milwaukee Police Department will submit monthly claims to the District Attorney's office for reimbursement of approximately one-twelfth of the amount authorized for reimbursement for the straight-time salary and fringe benefits of its officer, provided MMDEG grant funds are available for the entire year. The monthly claim will be \$3,519 ($\$42,228 / 12 = \$3,519$). The claims will be reviewed and approved by the MMDEG police director to verify the hours worked by the officer before payment by the District Attorney's office.

MMDEG is not a legal entity or governmental body corporate; rather, it is a multi-jurisdictional task force, comprised of the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office and the Milwaukee, South Milwaukee, and West Allis Police Departments. Therefore, financial responsibility for claims or damages arising out of the wrongful, intentional, reckless, or negligent acts or omissions of the South Milwaukee officer assigned to MMDEG, while the officer is performing or engaged in MMDEG task force activities, shall rest solely with the South Milwaukee Police Department and the city of South Milwaukee.

In the performance of work under this contract, the Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, national origin, age, sex, or handicap. The Contractor shall comply with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, which prohibits recipients of federal financial assistance from excluding from a program or activity, denying benefits of, or otherwise discriminating against a person on the basis of race, color, or national origin (42 U.S.C. § 2000d et seq.), as implemented by the Department of the Treasury's Title VI regulations, 31 CFR Part 22, which are herein incorporated by reference and made a part of this contract (or agreement). Title VI also includes protection to persons with "Limited English Proficiency" in any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance, 42 U.S.C. § 2000d et seq., as implemented by the Department of the Treasury's Title VI regulations, 31 CFR Part 22, and herein incorporated by reference and made a part of this contract or agreement.

The Contractor, its officers, directors, agents, partners and employees shall allow the County Audit Services Division and department contract administrators (collectively referred to as Designated Personnel) and any other party the Designated Personnel may name, with or without notice, to audit, examine and make copies of any and all records of the Contractor, Lessee, or other party to the contract, related to the terms and performance of the Contract for a period of up to three years following the date of last payment, the end date of this contract, or activity under this contract, whichever is later. Any subcontractors or other parties performing work on this Contract will be bound by the same terms and responsibilities as the Contractor. All subcontracts or other agreements for work performed on this Contract will include written notice that the subcontractors or other parties understand and will comply with the terms and responsibilities. The Contractor, Lessee, or other party to the contract, and any subcontractors understand and will abide by the requirements of Section 34.09 (Audit) and Section 34.095 (Investigations Concerning Fraud, Waste, and Abuse) of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances.

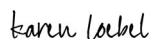

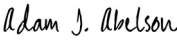
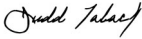

CONSUMER DISCLOSURE

From time to time, Wisconsin Milwaukee County (we, us or Company) may be required by law to provide to you certain written notices or disclosures. Described below are the terms and conditions for providing to you such notices and disclosures electronically through your DocuSign, Inc. (DocuSign) Express user account. Please read the information below carefully and thoroughly, and if you can access this information electronically to your satisfaction and agree to these terms and conditions, please confirm your agreement by clicking the 'I agree' button at the bottom of this document.

Getting paper copies

At any time, you may request from us a paper copy of any record provided or made available electronically to you by us. For such copies, as long as you are an authorized user of the DocuSign system you will have the ability to download and print any documents we send to you through your DocuSign user account for a limited period of time (usually 30 days) after such documents are first sent to you. After such time, if you wish for us to send you paper copies of any such documents from our office to you, you will be charged a \$0.00 per-page fee. You may request delivery of such paper copies from us by following the procedure described below.

Withdrawing your consent

If you decide to receive notices and disclosures from us electronically, you may at any time change your mind and tell us that thereafter you want to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format. How you must inform us of your decision to receive future notices and disclosure in paper format and withdraw your consent to receive notices and disclosures electronically is described below.

Consequences of changing your mind

If you elect to receive required notices and disclosures only in paper format, it will slow the speed at which we can complete certain steps in transactions with you and delivering services to you because we will need first to send the required notices or disclosures to you in paper format, and then wait until we receive back from you your acknowledgment of your receipt of such paper notices or disclosures. To indicate to us that you are changing your mind, you must withdraw your consent using the DocuSign 'Withdraw Consent' form on the signing page of your DocuSign account. This will indicate to us that you have withdrawn your consent to receive required notices and disclosures electronically from us and you will no longer be able to use your DocuSign Express user account to receive required notices and consents electronically from us or to sign electronically documents from us.
