The Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) is requesting that Milwaukee County Department of Transportation (MCDOT) be authorized to enter into Contract No. 03 (July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017) with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) to provide funds to MCTS for purposes of operating transit services under the Zoo interchange litigation settlement.
  - B. The Adopted 2016 Budget included revenues and expenses associated with transit services funded by contracts resulting from the zoo interchange litigation settlement. No budgetary impacts are anticipated as the cost for providing these transit routes and related services are fully offset with revenue from the State of Wisconsin.
  - C. The Adopted 2016 Budget included revenues and expenses associated with transit services funded by contracts resulting from the Zoo interchange litigation settlement. Expenses will not exceed revenues from the State of Wisconsin throughout the legal settlement agreement period.
