

From the Director, Department of Transportation and the President & CEO, Milwaukee County Transit System providing an action report regarding Title VI Equity Analysis, and Service and Fare Equity Analysis. This Action Report is also responsive to Reference File 26-26, by recommending adoption of the following:

A RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (Title VI) states, "No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance"; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) requires transit providers to prepare a Title VI Program Plan Update (the Plan Update) every three years to document compliance; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Plan Update is to ensure that transit services are provided in a non-discriminatory manner, to promote full and fair participation in transit decision making without regard to race, color, or national origin, and to ensure meaningful access to transit-related programs and activities by persons with limited English proficiency; and

WHEREAS, the FTA requires approval of the Plan Update by the County Executive and the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors prior to the submittal deadline of October 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Transportation and Transit (T&T), at its meeting of June 10, 2026, laid over File No. 26-493 to a date certain (July 15, 2026) (vote 5-0); and

WHEREAS, T&T, at its meeting of July 15, 2026, recommended adoption of File No. 26-493 (vote 5-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Milwaukee County Transit System's 2026 Title VI Program Plan Update and authorizes the Department of Transportation to submit the approved plan to the Federal Transit Administration.
