July 13, 2021: County Executive David Crowley signs “ARPA Task Force” resolution sponsored by Chairwoman Marcelia Nicholson

- Engage input from the community, especially underrepresented groups
- Develop non-binding recommendations for the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors
- Provide updates and recommendations to the county board until all ARPA monies are allocated

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Allowable Uses of the ARPA Funds



- Supporting the public health response
- Addressing negative economic impacts
- Supporting hardest-hit communities and families
- Providing premium pay for essential workers
- Investing in water, sewer and broadband
- Replacing the county's revenue losses

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Guiding Principles



- ARPA funds are temporary
- Scanning for partnerships (“last dollars in”)
- Balancing immediate needs with flexible timeline
- Alignment to strategic plan (investing in equity)
 - Investing “upstream” to address root causes of health disparities
 - Enhancing the county’s fiscal health and sustainability
 - Dismantling barriers to diverse and inclusive communities
