6 AN ORDINANCE

7 The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Milwaukee does ordain as
8 follows:

9 **SECTION 1.** Section 201.24(4.1) of the General Ordinances of Milwaukee County is
10 amended as follows:

11 **Section 4.1. Normal retirement.**

13 (1) (a) A member shall be eligible for a normal pension if his employment is terminated on or
14 after he has attained age fifty-five (55) and has completed thirty (30) years of service, or if his
15 employment is terminated on or after he has attained normal retirement age as defined in
16 section 2.18. Deputy Sheriffs shall be eligible to retire at age fifty-seven (57) regardless of their
17 number of years of service or at age fifty-five (55) with at least fifteen (15) years of creditable
18 pension service.

19 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (a), a member of the International
20 Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers whose initial membership date is before
21 January 1, 2012 shall not be eligible for a normal pension until the member has attained normal
22 retirement age as defined in section 2.18 and has completed five (5) years of service.

23 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subparagraph (a), a member of the Federation of
24 Nurses and Health Professionals whose initial membership date is before January 1, 2012 shall
25 not be eligible for a normal pension until the member has attained normal retirement age as
26 defined in section 2.18 and has completed five (5) years of service.

28 (2) Rule of 75.

29 (a) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is not covered by the
30 terms of a collective bargaining agreement, and whose initial membership in the retirement
31 system under section 201.24 began prior to January 1, 2006, and who retires on and after
32 September 1, 1993, shall be eligible for a normal pension when the age of the member when
33 added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but this provision shall not apply to any

34 member eligible under section 4.5 nor to any nonrepresented deputy sheriff who was hired as a
35 deputy sheriff after December 31, 1993 and whose appointment to a nonrepresented position
36 was first effective after June 30, 2009, nor to a member who was formerly a represented
37 correction officer who was hired as a correction officer after December 31, 1993 and who was
38 appointed to a non-represented position effective after May 1, 2011.

39 (b) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is covered by the terms of
40 a collective bargaining agreement with the American Federation of State, County and Municipal
41 Employees District Council 48, or with the Technicians, Engineers and Architects of Milwaukee
42 County, or with the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, and whose
43 initial membership date is prior to January 1, 1994, shall be eligible for a normal pension when
44 the age of the member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but this
45 provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.

46 (c) A member who, ~~on September 29, 2011,~~ is employed and is covered by the terms of
47 a collective bargaining agreement with the Federation of Nurses and Health Professionals, and
48 whose initial membership date is prior to January 1, ~~1997~~2013, shall be eligible for a normal
49 pension when the age of the member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five
50 (75), but this provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.

51 (d) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is covered by the terms of
52 a collective bargaining agreement with the Association of Milwaukee County Attorneys, and
53 whose initial membership date is prior to January 1, 2006, shall be eligible for a normal pension
54 when the age of the member when added to his years of service equals seventy-five (75), but
55 this provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.

56 (e) A member who, on September 29, 2011, is employed and is covered by the terms of
57 a collective bargaining agreement with the Milwaukee Building and Construction Trades
58 Council, and whose initial membership date is prior to February 21, 2006, shall be eligible for a
59 normal pension when the age of the member when added to his years of service equals
60 seventy-five (75), but this provision shall not apply to any member eligible under section 4.5.
