

1 (Item) From the Director, Office of Emergency Management (OEM), requesting  
2 authorization to create 1.0 Full-Time Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Supervisor  
3 Position to provide adequate supervision of Special Events Paramedics:

5 **A RESOLUTION**

7 WHEREAS, the Office of Emergency Management's EMS Division provides  
8 medical coverage to support contracted venues within the county to provide on-site  
9 Paramedic response capabilities through Special Events Paramedics; and  
10

11 WHEREAS, the number of special events, particularly at the Fiserv Forum, have  
12 increased resulting in more hours needed from Special Events Paramedics; and  
13

14 WHEREAS, the Special Events Paramedics staffing will need to increase  
15 significantly over the next 6 months to ensure event coverage is adequately provided.  
16 With the increase in staffing, the span of command and control must expand to match  
17 the growth of the program; and  
18

19 WHEREAS, the creation of one full-time EMS Supervisor position will provide the  
20 additional needed oversight for the increase in special events staffing; and  
21

22 WHEREAS, the cost of the EMS Supervisor position is completely reimbursed by  
23 the contracted venues for no tax levy impact; therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby  
26 authorizes and approves the creation of one (1.0) EMS Supervisor position to meet  
27 operational needs in the OEM EMS Division, beginning January 2020:

31 administrative fund transfer recognizing revenues and expenditures in an amount not  
32 to exceed \$57,054 by DAS and the Office of the Comptroller, for the purpose of wages,  
33 social security and full reimbursement for this position in 2020.
