The resolution also encourages Parks Department staff to provide information to the public about the detrimental impact of balloon releases.
- B. There are no direct costs associated with this resolution. Existing staff time would be needed to communicate the contents of this resolution to the relevant state representatives and agencies, and for Parks Department staff to provide information to the public in newsletters and programs.
- C. No budgetary impacts are expected in this or subsequent years. This resolution would not authorize the expenditure of any additional funds.
