**REQUEST**

Milwaukee County Parks request to create 1.0 FTE Area of Concern (AOC) Project Manager.

**BACKGROUND**

The Milwaukee Estuary is an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) listed Great Lakes Area of Concern (AOC). Milwaukee County Parks in conjunction with the EPA, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) and other governmental and non-profit agencies have been working together on various grant funded projects to remove impairments from the waterways since 2019.

In 2019, the Milwaukee County Board authorized the creation of the Area of Concern Program Supervisor (File #19-688) which has served as the primary contact between Milwaukee County Parks and grant funding partners. This position is entirely grant funded. Due to significant progress on AOC projects, additional funding is being considered by the EPA to increase the pace of work within the Milwaukee Estuary. This additional work exceeds the available personnel capacity within the Parks Department. Milwaukee County Parks requests the creation of an Area of Concern Project Manager to coordinate and manage any upcoming grant approved projects for the Milwaukee Estuary Area of Concern. This position will also be fully funded through the grants to execute the projects.
