• The new ProPhoenix update has addressed many issues, but not all. Sonali is coordinating testing for the remaining issues.

NEW BUSINESS

- 7. Discussion about ideas for adding new topics for this board to work on going forward
 - In the previous meeting Mr. Lemmers suggested a whitepaper that municipalities could use for moving away from T1 lines and transitioning to fiber, which is necessary for ESInet. Mr. Lemmers is absent today. Advised he is working on the next steps.
 - Mr. Carrion discussed the move to NG911 and the necessary geo updates. The County
 has been working on cleaning up and prepping the data for the master database format.
 Concerns about all municipalities needing to complete the same geo updates before
 being able to move forward with NG911. The County's Land Info office could assist with
 getting the information ready if all municipalities would be comfortable with the County
 completing this task.
 - AC Mayer inquired about the parameters for the geodatabase submissions from municipalities. Kevin Bruhn advised that there would be addresses and street center line layers that would need to be maintained. Currently, ESInet is 100% compliant and being kept up to date. Just looking for more authority to move forward with the information.
 - Ms. Scharnott advised that BCC would want to tie in Phoenix. Mr. Carrion advised this database would not impact the Phoenix database.
 - Ms. Scharnott advised Mr. Bruhn to write up a request for permission from the municipalities to move forward with the database. Request will summarize the requirements. No deadline or forecasted date was given.
- 8. Mr. Carrion provided an update on Cyber Attacks.
 - The county has engaged Motorola for a 24/7 monitoring against real-time attacks, "Active Eye". Currently tied into radio. Could this be something to tie into CAD/911 systems? Other municipalities may be interested. Ms. Scharnott agreed with the potential.
- 9. RapidSOS no longer applicable. Change to a demo of Motorola Active Eye, for cyber protection for the next meeting.
- 10. Next meeting Still quarterly, 3rd Tuesday's at 11a Ms. Patterson will schedule.
