From the Director, Department of Transportation, Requesting the Continued Extension of Mr. Mickey Critton’s Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification (TAHC) to the Position of Assistant Highway Maintenance Supervisor from November 1, 2019 Through January 30, 2020 or Until the Position is Filled, by recommending adoption of the following:

**A RESOLUTION**

WHEREAS, Chapter 17.085 of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances requires that an extension of Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification (TAHC) beyond 180 days be approved by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Transportation requests the continuation of Mr. Mickey Critton’s TAHC to the position of Assistant Highway Maintenance Supervisor from November 1, 2019, through January 30, 2020, or until the position is filled; and

WHEREAS, the request is being made to maintain consistent leadership during the snow season until the Superintendent position has been created and filled; and

WHEREAS, once the Superintendent position is filled, the Interim Highway Maintenance Director will return to his permanent position of Assistant Highway Maintenance Manager, and the Interim Assistant Highway Maintenance Manager will return to his permanent position of Assistant Highway Maintenance Supervisor; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Critton will then return to his permanent position of Highway Maintenance Worker upon the filling of the Superintendent position; and

WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of October 23, 2019, recommended adoption of File No. 19-790 (vote 3-0); now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby approves the continued extension of Mr. Mickey Critton’s Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification (TAHC) to the position of Assistant Highway Maintenance Supervisor from November 1, 2019, through January 30, 2020, or until the position is filled.
