Re: W. College Avenue (S. 27th Street to S. 35th Street)

Mr. Murphy,

I am responding to your July 18, 2017, letter seeking City of Franklin support for signage to W. College Avenue between S. 27th Street and S. 35th Street. You indicated that the County is considering the installation of no-parking signs and we understand that you are also installing no passing signs.

Last night, the Common Council made such support with the exception of the western end past the Woods Apartments (3311 W. College Ave) where there is a traditional curb and gutter section.

You also indicated that the county would like to City to consider installation of delineators to separate the motorists from the pedestrians. With the County's permission, I would like to add an intermediate step of striping the rumble strip as red. Per the MUTCD section 3G.01, it appears that any non white or yellow colors for this situation are acceptable.

After the posting of no parking, passing, and our striping, I will instruct the Franklin Police Department to monitor and ticket as needed. If motorists are still crossing the rumble strip after all of those efforts, I will install delineators.

Thank you for your efforts on this inter-local cooperation.
