This action to change the scoring from the Committee on Governance, Finance, and Evaluation to the Leadership Committee per the authority provided to the Co-Chairs to make decisions regarding

the application process between meetings.

Background: At its December 20, 2023 Committee of the Whole meeting, the Milwaukee County Youth Commission unanimously approved an action item to request that the Committee on Governance, Finance, and Evaluation take up this item.

Proposed: The Milwaukee County Youth Commission respectfully requests that the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors amends Chapter 106.03(4) of the General Ordinances to add a permanent at-large seat on the Milwaukee County Youth Commission to be occupied by a young person aged 14-18 in Milwaukee County who is experiencing housing insecurity at the time of application.

3. Resolution to clarify that confirmation of Youth Commissioners by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors can be retroactive to expedite the onboarding process of new Youth Commissioners (Action Item)

Proposed: The Milwaukee County Youth Commission respectfully requests that Adult Advisor Supervisor Kathleen Vincent authors and advances a resolution to amend Chapter 106.03(2) of the General Ordinances to clarify that confirmation of Youth Commissioners by the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors can be retroactive to expedite the onboarding process of new Youth Commissioners.
