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12 WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel reviews each month a report from the
13 Department of Human Resources (DHR) relative to: Reclassification of Existing
14 positions (classified and unclassified); Advancements within the Pay Range;
15 Appointments at an Advanced Step of the Pay Range; Revisions to Executive
16 Compensation Plan positions; Dual Employment; Emergency Appointments; Temporary
17 Appointments; and Temporary Assignments to a Higher Classification; and

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19 WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of July 12, 2018,
20 reviewed the July 2018 report from DHR that contained the notification that 24 House of
21 Correction positions were to be reclassified to a Correctional Officer Sergeant position;
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24 WHEREAS, the 2016 Adopted Budget abolished all unfunded positions and any
25 positions not specifically authorized in the Budget; and

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27 WHEREAS, the position classification of Correctional Officer Sergeant was
28 eliminated at that time because there were no filled and authorized positions included in
29 the 2016 Adopted Budget or in subsequent budgets; and

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31 WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Committee on Personnel to establish the
32 position and set the compensation for the position as this is the authority and
33 responsibility of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors; and

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35 WHEREAS, upon creation of the classification of Correctional Officer Sergeant,
36 the DHR will be able to process the proposed reclassifications to the Correctional
37 Officer Sergeant position as outlined in the July report; and

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39 WHEREAS, the Committee on Personnel, at its meeting of July 12, 2018,
40 recommended adoption of this By the Committee Resolution, which approves the
41 authorization of the proposed reclassifications as outlined in the report dated
42 June 22, 2018 (vote 4-0); now, therefore,
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44 BE IT RESOLVED, the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors hereby
45 authorizes the position of Correctional Officer Sergeant in existing pay range 21M that
46 has five steps, with annual pay beginning at \$44,684.85 in Step 1 and \$51,582.00 in
47 Step 5.

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
