- A. The Director of the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) is requesting authorization to execute two passive review amendments to purchase of service contracts with Wisconsin Community Services for the Saturday Alternative Sanctions Program and Evening Reporting Center.
- B. Total 2019 expenditures included in this request are \$169,045. This reflects an amendment of \$90,295 for the Saturday Alternative Sanctions Program and \$78,750 for the Evening Reporting Center. Because the 2019 Budget anticipated that the two programs would be combined and achieve a savings of \$235,000, the continuation of separate contracts for these programs at a higher rate results in additional spending of about \$117,000. This cost can be absorbed within the 8000 contractual services account series for DYFS.
- C. There is no tax levy impact associated with approval of this request in 2019 as funds sufficient to cover associated expenditures are included in the DYFS 2019 Budget.
- D. This fiscal note assumes expenditures will not exceed the amounts authorized for this purchase of service contract.
