A. The Office of the Comptroller is requesting approval to process an administrative appropriation transfer to reconcile surplus and deficits in projects that will be closed (listed on Schedules A and B); lapse the remaining estimated \$930,271 of net surplus funds from lapsing Corporate Purpose projects to the Debt Service Reserve.

B. There are no direct costs. See item C for budgetary impact.

C. Non-airport capital project fund expenditure appropriations of \$4,514,763 and budgeted revenues of \$3,584,492 are requested to be lapsed.

Excluding Airport appropriations and revenues, a net surplus of \$930,271 will be deposited into the County's debt service reserve.

Airport capital project fund expenditure appropriations of \$1,441,433 and budgeted revenues of \$1,441,433 are requested to be lapsed.

D. All final closing entries have been made for projects requested to be lapsed. If additional entries are made, then the lapsed amounts will be modified as needed.
